Fredericksburg Festival for the Performing Arts (FFPA) has had quite a year! Here are the highlights:

- In the spring we sponsored the **Virginia Opera** in 11 schools to over 5,000 elementary school children.
- We had our **27th Chamber Music Festival** in May with record attendance. We again sponsored the **Young Artists Competition**, with the winners performing at each Chamber concert and with the **Rappahannock POPS Orchestra**.
- Our **Arts-in-Motion** program brought six musical performances to underserved portions of our community.

- **Love Canon**, a Bluegrass/80's band, rocked the afternoon in September at a family-friendly event that had 300 people of all ages asking for a repeat performance next year.

But we aren't stopping there! Here's what we are planning for 2015:

- **House Concert**—an afternoon of Bach and Bordeaux at Braehead, featuring our artistic director and renown cellist, Michael Reynolds, at the beautiful and historical Braehead Manor in Battlefield Park on Sunday, January 11.
- **Young Artists Competition**—Finals Concert on Saturday, January 17, at Chancellor Baptist Church.
- **Annual Gala**—Friday, March 6, at Bowman Distillery with the Fredericksburg Big Band.

- **Virginia Opera**—sponsoring 14 performances to well over 5,000 local students in the spring of 2015.
- **28th Chamber Music Festival** at Trinity Episcopal Church on May 19-22, 2015, with a possible 4th concert at Stratford Hall.
